### **Activities and Accomplishments: 7/1/18 - 6/30/19**

- Served a total of 3,345 people.
- Responded to 3,634 crisis calls.
- Sheltered 154 adults and 48 children for 6,479 total safe bed-nights.
- Received support from 90 volunteers to provide 6,474 hours of services for victims.
- Supported 937 people accessing help through criminal and civil court systems.
  - Assisted 586 people to obtain Domestic Violence Protective Orders.
  - Supported 22 people to serve as witnesses in trials where their abuser was found guilty of criminal acts against them.
- Administered 456 Danger Assessments.
- Helped survivors form 7,047 safety plans.
- Educated our community by providing 244 education events, reaching 7,633 people.
- 91% of survivors served reported that they felt more connected and aware of available safety and stability resources as a result of the support they received at Helpmate.
- 93% of survivors served reported an increased understanding of power and control within intimate partner relationships after receiving Helpmate services.
- 93% of survivors served reported that they have improved their own safety strategies.
- Helped 1,565 survivors to develop a personalized safety plan.
- Provided specialized Child and Family Advocacy and Children's Services to 450 children impacted by domestic violence.
