### Activities and Accomplishments: 7/1/19 - 6/30/20

- Served a total of 3,250 people.
- Responded to 3,669 crisis calls.
- Sheltered 144 adults and 96 children for 6,479 total safe bed-nights.
- Received support from 69 volunteers to provide 4,686.5 hours of services for victims.
- Supported 842 people accessing help through criminal and civil court systems.
  - Assisted 522 people to obtain Domestic Violence Protective Orders.
  - Supported 22 people to serve as witnesses in trials where their abuser was found guilty of criminal acts against them.
- Administered 743 Danger Assessments.
- Helped 2,130 survivors form 6,507 personalized safety plans.
- Educated our community by providing 172 education events, reaching 6,024 people.
- 84% of survivors served reported that they felt more connected and aware of available safety and stability resources as a result of the support they received at Helpmate.
- 89% of survivors served reported an increased understanding of power and control within intimate partner relationships after receiving Helpmate services.
- 88% of survivors served reported that they have improved their own safety strategies.
- Provided specialized Child and Family Advocacy and Children's Services to 395 children impacted by domestic violence.
