Activities and Accomplishments: 7/1/21 - 6/30/22

- Served a total of 3,660 people.
- Responded to 3,790 crisis calls.
- Sheltered 271 adult and children survivors, providing a total of 5,091 safe bed nights.
- Received support from 95 volunteers to provide 9,661 hours of services for victims.
 - Supported 1,177 people accessing help through criminal and civil court systems.
 - \circ $\;$ Assisted 431 people to obtain Domestic Violence Protective Orders.
 - Supported 18 people to serve as witnesses in trials where their abuser was found guilty of criminal acts against them.
- Administered 1,196 Danger Assessments.
- Helped 3,148 survivors form 16,253 personalized safety plans.
- Educated our community by providing 142 education events, reaching 2,891 people.
- 92% of survivors served reported that they felt more connected and aware of available safety and stability resources as a result of the support they received at Helpmate.
- 97% of survivors served reported an increased understanding of power and control within intimate partner relationships after receiving Helpmate services.
- 92% of survivors served reported that they have improved their own safety strategies.
- Provided specialized Child and Family Advocacy and Children's Services to 839 children impacted by domestic violence.
